Jan Aadhaar - Key Features

- An All-inclusive Family Database- A socio-economic registry for all the families of the state
- Unified DBT platform for End-to end service delivery platform a large number of Schemes and Services -Single Source of Truth
- Financial Inclusion Bank account of family members
- Women Empowerment Women is the HoF. All family-based benefit to be transferred to the bank account of HoF
- State Resident Data Hub Legitimate Resident data accessible to all departmental applications.
- Replacement for all Types of Cards- Ration Database has already been replaced in state
- Scope of Real-time Census of the State by leveraging the Pehchan integration Daily birth and death updation
- **Standardisation** of key databases **across** State.
- Tool for planning new social security and social welfare schemes- Accurate estimates for planning
- Vehicle for Implementation of Auto and Deemed Approval and Right based Entitlement

Components of Rajasthan Jan Aadhaar Yojana



Jan Aadhaar Resident Data Repository

A single, clean, authentic, deduplicated and up-to-date master database of State residents Resident Identity Card - Jan Aadhaar e-Card

All residents enrolled under Rajasthan Jan Aadhaar Yojana are eligible to get Jan Aadhaar Card

Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT)

Umbrella platform for all government departments which are delivering cash or non-cash benefits/ services to the residents

Transaction Mapper

Details of benefits a family/ individual is availing under a scheme and entitlement for schemes as per eligibility. Useful for Social Audit.


Some Unique Facts about Jan Aadhaar Social Registry

- Jan Aadhaar covers more than 97% of the projected population of the State
- Aadhaar saturation in Jan Aadhaar Resident Data Repository- 95%
- Aadhaar authenticated through UIDAI Authentication platform- 80%
- Mobile Numbers seeded; at least of one Member of the families- 95%
- All 3 genders i.e., male, female & transgender can get enrolled in Jan Aadhaar
- Total Bank Accounts seeded- 37.5 Million, 78% Bank Accounts are validated from NPCI.
- **Social Audit** (twice a year) of benefits delivered through Jan Aadhaar through Gram Sabha and Ward Samiti. The reports are uploaded on Jan Soochna portal.
