NOTIFICATION

**Jaipur, April 15, 2024**

**S.O.03** .-Whereas the use of Aadhaar or Jan Aadhaar as an identity document for delivery of services or benefits or subsidies simplifies the Government delivery processes, brings in transparency and efficiency, and enables beneficiaries to get their entitlements directly in a convenient and seamless manner by obviating the need to produce multiple documents to prove one's identity;

And whereas, the Women and Child Development Department, hereinafter referred to as the Department, is administering the Indira Gandhi Matritva Poshan Yojna-IGMPY, hereinafter referred to as the Scheme, which is being implemented through the Directorate, Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS), hereinafter referred to as the Implementing Agency;

And whereas, under the Scheme, cash benefit of Rs. 6,000/- in five instalments, hereinafter referred to as the benefit to bank account of the beneficiaries is given to the second time pregnant women, hereinafter referred to as the beneficiaries, by the Implementing Agency as per the extant Scheme guidelines;

And whereas, the aforesaid Scheme integrated/to be integrated with Jan Aadhaar platform, involves recurring expenditure incurred from the Consolidated Fund of the State.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 7 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (Central Act No. 18 of 2016), hereinafter referred to as the said Act and section 3, 4 and 14 of the Rajasthan Jan-Aadhaar Authority Act, 2020 (Act No. 3 of 2020), the State Government hereby notifies the following, namely:-

- (I) An individual eligible for receiving the benefits under the Scheme shall hereby be required to furnish proof of possession of the Jan Aadhaar number or undergo Jan Aadhaar authentication.
- (II) Any individual desirous of availing benefits under the Scheme, who does not possess the Jan Aadhaar number or, has not yet enrolled for Jan Aadhaar, shall be required to make application for Jan Aadhaar enrolment before registering for the

Scheme provided that beneficiary is entitled to obtain Jan Aadhaar as per the provisions of Chapter III of the Rajasthan Jan-Aadhaar Authority Act, 2020 (Act No. 3 of 2020), and such individuals shall visit any e-Mitra centre or self through Single Sign On of Government of Rajasthan to get enrolled for Jan Aadhaar.

- (III) as per the provisions of Chapter III of the Rajasthan Jan-Aadhaar Authority Act, 2020 (Act No. 3 of 2020), every resident family of the State shall be entitled, through its head or through any eldest or adult member, to obtain Jan-Aadhaar Card by submitting identity information and photograph of all its members in the prescribed manner.
2. On receipt of the identity information and photograph of the members of the family under clause 1 above, the Authority shall, after verifying the information enrol the family and assign to the family a unique Jan-Aadhaar ID which shall be a unique random number.
3. In order to provide benefits to the beneficiaries under the Scheme conveniently, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall make all the required arrangements to ensure that wide publicity through the media shall be given to the beneficiaries to make them aware of the said requirement.
4. In all cases, where Aadhaar or Jan Aadhaar authentication fails due to poor biometrics of the beneficiaries or due to any other reason, the following remedial mechanisms shall be adopted, namely:-
- (I) in case of poor fingerprint quality, Integrated Risk Information System scan or face authentication facility shall be adopted for authentication, thereby the Department shall make provisions for Integrated Risk Information System scanners or face authentication along with finger-print authentication for delivery of benefits in seamless manner;
- (II) in case the biometric authentication through fingerprints or Integrated Risk Information System scan or face authentication is not successful, wherever feasible and admissible authentication by Aadhaar One Time Password or Time-based One-Time Password with limited time validity, as the case may be, shall be offered;
- (III) in all other cases where biometric or Aadhaar or Jan Aadhaar One Time Password or Time-based One-Time Password authentication is not possible, benefits under the Scheme may be given on the basis of physical Aadhaar or Jan Aadhaar letter whose authenticity can be verified through the Quick Response code printed on the Aadhaar letter and the necessary arrangement of Quick Response code reader shall be provided at the convenient locations by the Department concerned.
5. This notification shall come into force from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
