F.15 (1) Dev/2021-00113. -Whereas, the use of Aadhaar or Jan-Aadhaar as an identity document for delivery of services or benefits or subsidies simplifies the Government delivery processes, brings in transparency and efficiency, and enables beneficiaries to get their entitlements directly in a convenient and seamless manner by obviating the need to produce multiple documents to prove one's identity;

And whereas, the Devasthan Department, Government of Rajasthan, hereinafter referred to as the Department, is administering the Varishath Nagrik Tirth Yatra Yojana, hereinafter referred to as the Scheme, to provide government facilities and assistance to senior citizens of the Rajasthan aged 60 years and above to visit any designated pilgrimage place within the country/outside the country once in their lifetime, which is being implemented through the Assistant Commissioner offices of Devasthan Department, hereinafter referred to as the Implementing Agency;

And whereas, under the Scheme, the senior citizens of Rajasthan, hereinafter referred to as the beneficiaries, are given the benefit of free pilgrimage once in their lifetime, hereinafter referred to as the benefit, by the Implementing Agency as per the extant Scheme guidelines;

And whereas, the aforesaid Scheme integrated/to be integrated with the Jan-Aadhaar platform, involves recurring expenditure incurred from the Consolidated Fund of State of Rajasthan.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 7 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (Central Act No. 18 of 2016), hereinafter referred to as the said Act and section 3, section 4 and section 14 of the Rajasthan Jan-Aadhaar Authority Act, 2020 (Act No. 3 of 2020), the State Government hereby notifies the following, namely:-

1. (i) An individual eligible for receiving the benefits under the Scheme shall hereby be required to furnish proof of possession of the Aadhaar number or Jan-Aadhaar or undergo Aadhaar authentication or Jan-Aadhaar authentication.
- (ii) Any individual desirous of availing benefits under the Scheme, who does not possess the Aadhaar number or Jan-Aadhaar or, has not yet enrolled for Aadhaar or Jan-Aadhaar, shall be required to make application for Aadhaar or Jan-Aadhaar enrolment before registering for the Scheme provided that he is entitled to obtain Aadhaar as per section 3 of the said Act and or Jan-Aadhaar as per the provisions of Chapter-III of the Rajasthan Jan-Aadhaar Authority Act, 2020 (Act No. 3 of 2020), and such individuals shall visit any Aadhaar enrolment centre (list available at the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) website www.uidai.gov.in) to get enrolled for Aadhaar and e-Mitra centre of self through Single Sign On of Government of Rajasthan to get enrolled for Jan-Aadhaar.

- (iii) As per the provisions of Chapter-III of the Rajasthan Jan-Aadhaar Authority Act, 2020 (Act No. 3 of 2020), every resident family of the State shall be entitled, through its head or through any eldest or adult member, to obtain Jan-Aadhaar Card by submitting identity information and photograph of all its members in the prescribed manner.
- (iv) As per regulation 12 of the Aadhaar (Enrolment and Update) Regulations, 2016, the Department through its Implementing Agency, is required to offer Aadhaar enrolment facilities for the beneficiaries who are not yet enrolled for Aadhaar and in case there is no Aadhaar enrolment centre located in the respective Block or Tehsil, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall provide Aadhaar enrolment facilities at convenient locations in coordination with the existing Registrars of UIDAI or by becoming a UIDAI Registrar themselves:

Provided that till the time Aadhaar and Jan-Aadhaar is assigned to the individual, benefits under the Scheme shall be given to such individual subject to the production of the following documents, namely:-

- (a) If he has enrolled, his Aadhaar Enrolment identification slip and Jan-Aadhaar Enrolment Identification slip; and
- (b) Any one of the following documents, namely:-
- (i) Bank or Post office Passbook with Photo; or
 - (ii) Permanent Account Number (PAN) Card; or
 - (iii) Passport; or
 - (iv) Ration Card; or
 - (v) Voter identity Card; or
 - (vi) MGNREGA card; or
 - (vii) Kisan Photo passbook; or
 - (viii) Driving license issued by the Licensing Authority under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act No. 59 of 1988); or
 - (ix) Certificate of identity having photo of such person issued by a Gazetted Officer or a Tehsildar on an official letter head; or
 - (x) Any other document as specified by the Department.

Provided further that the above documents may be checked by an officer specifically designated by the Department for that purpose.

2. In order to provide benefits to the beneficiaries under the Scheme conveniently, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall make all the required arrangements to ensure that wide publicity through the media shall be given to the beneficiaries to make them aware of the said requirement.

3. In all cases, where Aadhaar or Jan-Aadhaar authentication fails due to poor biometrics of the beneficiaries or due to any other reason, the following remedial mechanisms shall be adopted, namely:-

- (i) in case of poor fingerprint quality, Integrated Risk Information System (iris) scan or face authentication facility shall be adopted for authentication, thereby the Department through its Implementing Agency shall make provisions for iris scanners or face authentication along with fingerprint authentication for delivery of benefits in seamless manner;
- (ii) in case the biometric authentication through fingerprints or Integrated Risk Information System (iris) scan or face authentication is not successful, wherever

feasible and admissible authentication by Aadhaar or Jan-Aadhaar One Time Password or Time based One Time Password with limited time validity, as the case may be, shall be offered:

- (iii) in all other cases where biometric or Aadhaar or Jan-Aadhaar One Time Password or Time based One Time Password authentication is not possible, benefits under the Scheme may be given on the basis of physical Aadhaar or Jan-Aadhaar letter whose authenticity can be verified through the Quick Response (QR) code printed on the Aadhaar or Jan-Aadhaar letter and the necessary arrangement of Quick Response (QR) code reader shall be provided at the convenient locations by the Department through its Implementing Agency.
4. In addition to the above, in order to ensure that no bona fide beneficiary under the Scheme is deprived of his due benefits, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall follow the exception handling mechanism as outlined in the Office Memorandum of DBT Mission, Cabinet Secretariat, Government of India dated 19th December 2017.
5. This notification shall come into effect from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
